Information for Business Owners, Condo Boards

This is a courtesy message from the Village of Oak Park.

A change to state law means that commercial accounts with more than 15,000 kWh annual usage are no longer eligible to participate in municipal aggregation.

These accounts include small businesses and certain residential condo buildings that use commercial accounts for their common areas. Based on recent data, your commercial account may no longer be eligible for municipal aggregation.

You have until May 8 to make a decision about your commercial account.

GET THE FACTS - Call ComEd at 1-800-Edison-1 (1-800-334-7661) and find out if your commercial account is eligible for municipal aggregation.

DO NOTHING - If you choose to do nothing, you will be enrolled in ComEd's default rate for one year.

SHOP AROUND - Go to **www.pluginillinois.org** and choose another supplier from a state-approved list. Prices and contracts are competitive. Keep an eye on contract rates and terms!

GO GREEN - Many energy providers offer 100% green (renewable) sources.
